During the month we launched a big attack on thistles in the area between the small reservoir and Mt Arawang. Many thousands were cut or sprayed, the work is not yet completed.

George and I have been watering the plants put in at the last meeting and most of them are surviving if not thriving. I hope we will have rain before the next meeting as I have bursarias waiting to go in.

I have got a seed-collecting permit for Clair, Sandra, Pauline, Ann, Tina, Dianne and Judy, it needs renewing in July so does anyone else wish to be added to that list for next year? You have to keep a record of what you take and use it for the Ridge.

It was agreed last group day that the next Park Care day would be Sunday 11th May, a good day to get Mothers out as well! It will again be at Guinness Place and you will be able to drive your car up to the reservoir.

Six-monthly report sheets will be given out to caretakers next month. If you haven't visited your patch lately now is the time to make amends.
